

Good Government for San Bernardino

In November, voters in San Bernardino County will decide their future by choosing between two competing measures, Measure J and Measure K, each of which would amend the county charter, our founding document.

VOTE YES ON MEASURE J!

Measure J, has been placed on the ballot by the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors after a collaborative, community-based process. It provides **REAL** charter reform by doing the following:

- **TERM LIMITS:** Measure J reinforces tough term limits, preventing supervisors from “resetting the clock” by moving to another district and running for office again.
- **LOBBYIST REFORM:** Measure J will result in landmark lobbying transparency in San Bernardino County, letting the public know which special interests lobby our county government.
- **REDISTRICTING:** Measure J will make redistricting for supervisors a transparent process by creating a platform for citizen involvement, ensuring ordinary residents have a real voice and preventing elected officials from working behind closed doors to rig the results.
- **EQUALITY:** Measure J will modernize the county charter by ensuring that it embodies modern expectations on race, gender, and sexual orientation.
- **EMERGENCY RESPONSE:** Measure J ensures our county has the leadership it needs during emergencies like global pandemics, massive fire storms, and other crises that require quick and effective responses.

VOTE NO ON MEASURE K!

Measure K has been placed on the ballot by a predatory multi-millionaire who does not live in our county but profits from the lives and tax dollars of our residents. Measure K will do the following:

- **REDUCE** the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors to a part-time position, making it impossible for them to respond to emergencies that require full-time work and their complete attention.
- **EMPOWER LOBBYISTS** to take control by limiting any supervisor to a single four-year term – not enough time for them to solve big challenges or push back on lobbyists’ special interests.
- **SILENCE** hundreds of thousands of voices from minority and working communities by creating board positions that will appeal only to the wealthy.
- **DENY** our county its fair share of state and federal dollars, by reducing the ability of supervisors to advocate for these much-needed funds.
- **ELIMINATE ACCOUNTABILITY** by encouraging supervisors to serve special interests without repercussion, as they will never again face the voters.
- **CORRUPT** functioning government, creating disruptions to vital county services.

The residents of San Bernardino County shouldn’t be subject to this multi-millionaire’s political experiment, especially when it will line his pocket and empower only the wealthy.
